BYLAW No. 149/10

A BYLAW TO LICENCE MINING CONTRACTORS AND WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 9(1)(a) OF THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT, 2006.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head #156, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- For the purpose of this bylaw, the word "contractor" shall include any person, firm, or corporation.
- Every well-drilling contractor in the municipality, shall before undertaking welldrilling in the municipality, pay to the municipality the following licence fee:
 - a) For the drilling of a horizontal well, vertical well or each subsequent leg Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00).
 - b) For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information –

 Two Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars (\$225.00)
- Any contractor holding a licence under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his licence when required to do so by the licence inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.

Bylaw No. 213/99 is hereby repealed.
