A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL TO EXPEND MUNICIPAL FUNDS FOR REPAIRS IN AN EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO SECTION 31 OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- Members of Council are hereby authorized to expend for repairs in the case of an emergency to public works an amount not exceeding an aggregate of \$1,000.00 unless approved by Council.
- Where a member of council authorized an expenditure for repairs of an emergent nature to public works, the amount and nature of the expenditure shall be presented to council for approval at the next regular council meeting.
- 3. Prior to the expenditure of any funds pursuant to Section 1, the approval of the reeve, in his absence the deputy reeve, must be obtained.
